- 4. Identified additional green plots at #23, AND #12, #19, #26, #75, and #82 (possibly 6@20x20ft or 24@10x10ft).
- 5. Identified four additional 5x10 plots at #3, #10 #17 and #24 (four 5x10 plots on east boundary of each plot).
- 6. Planning October 21nd Annual Fall Community Volunteer Cemetery Clean up <u>Nancy</u>

-publicity Provincetown Independent, church bulletins, and website -contact DPW for contractor bags and arrange for debris pick up. <u>Skip and Ditty</u>

-put up "clean up banner" at Fire Dept. by Sunday, October 15th. Sign material will be stored in vault.

7. Discussion about grant opportunities to create more user-friendly and accurate mapping for cemeteries: squared off maps with room for plot owners, etc. Skip will research what other cape towns have done to address these issues (drones, GPS, etc).

8.Skip reported on activity by Kerouach Rd neighbor's repeated removal of pipe fencing to access their workyard through cemetery. David will contact neighbor again and request cease and desist activity. David will contact Wellfleet Arbor Committee about donating a few trees to plant at the location of this activity.

9.Nancy reported on request to Town accountant for a statement of our past year expenditure and revenue funds.

10.Old Business

Closing out CPC grant through restoration work by John Fougere. There is still \$2,000. (Remaining funds must be spent by October 19, 2023) unless we request an extension which Nancy will do if necessary.
