Down Payment and Closing Cost Assistance Program



The Town of Wellfleet is providing a zero-interest deferred payment loan of <u>up to</u> \$20,000 to qualified moderate-income applicants to help 1st-time homebuyers afford to buy a home in the community. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, submitted to the Town Administrator's Office at 300 Main Street.

Your income must be within median income limits for the Barnstable area such as \$60,340 for a household of 1, \$68,960 for 2 persons, \$77,580 for 3 persons, \$86,200 for 4 persons, etc.

You cannot have more than \$75,000 in financial assets.

You must complete an approved homebuyer training course. You must obtain a mortgage from a recognized commercial lender based on specific requirements.

You must provide a minimum of 1.5% of the purchase price in your own funds towards the loan closing.
