Preface

This is the listing of the Duck Creek Cemetery, Wellfleet, Massachusetts.

(As written in the original index published by the Rich Family Association)

"Situated at the junction of Route 6 and Cahoon's Hollow Road, not far from the center of the town, this cemetery was the burial ground for the second location of the Wellfleet Congregational Church. From 1740 to 1850 the church stood at the head of Duck Creek, the cemetery behind it on a knoll which slopes to the edge of the present highway.

Miss Elizabeth Freeman of Wellfleet became interested several years ago in the restoration and preservation of this historic old burial ground. With donations from individuals and the Town of Wellfleet, and a large personal contribution, Miss Freeman initiated the work of resetting and mending about one hundred of the stones, which were fast falling into decay.

In 1961 Miss Freeman proceeded to copy from the stones all the information which was still legible. This booklet is the result of her many hours of copying, checking, and listing. At the time she did her field work, Miss Freeman was over seventy years of age. Her work, both in restoring the cemetery and preserving the data from it, is truly a labor of love."

Now, in the year 2014, the Cemetery Commission has taken upon itself the task of updating Miss Freeman's work, professionally surveying the cemetery and digitalizing the data to ensure future generations the ability to research and appreciate all those who came before. Again the cemetery is in need of repair and replacement. We have already replaced and reset many of the stones and with a grant from the Wellfleet Community Preservation Committee many more will be restored. While doing our research we also found several stones which had previously been overlooked.

This project could not have been completed without the considerable help of Bonnie Robicheau, Commissioner, David Agger, Commissioner, Nancy Vail, Commissioner, Richard Robicheau, Marcia Sexton, and Brita Tate.
